The protection function of the Ombudsman is enshrined in the Fundamental Law of Hungary. According to Article 30 paragraph (1): "The Commissioner for Fundamental Rights shall undertake activities aimed at protecting fundamental rights. The Commissioner's proceedings may be requested by anyone.

(2) The Commissioner for Fundamental Rights shall himself or herself investigate - or have investigated by others - any wrong related to fundamental rights that have come to his or her knowledge, and shall initiate general or specific measures for their remedy."

The promotion function is a useful and efficient way for awareness raising therefore the Ombudsman issues press releases informing on his inquiries, projects and appears regularly in the media.

"There was an increase of almost 10 per cent in the number of communications issued by the Commissioner, the number of his media appearances grew by approximately 20 per cent and the presentation in the media of the phenomena and events forming the background of his inquiries rose by more than 15 per cent. It was quite apparent that the online media was gaining ground: in each month of the year it led by far the statistics of coverage of the activity of the Commissioner and of the phenomena inquired into (1881 in 2011 compared to 1315 in 2010)."(2011 Annual Report of the Commissioner)
