OPCAT inspection of the weekly countrywide transport of the detainees

On 9-10 December 2019, staff members of the National Preventive Mechanism visited the Budapest Strict and Medium Security Prison.



The purpose of the visit was to inspect the weekly countrywide transport of the detainees, the activity in connection with the weekly countrywide transport and the transport vehicles.
