OPCAT visit to the Baracska facility of the Central Transdanubian National Prison

The staff members of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism Department acting on behalf of the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights paid an unannounced visit to the Baracska facility of the Central Transdanubian National Prison on April 24-25, 2019.



The purpose of the visit was to investigate into the treatment of the detainees and the circumstances of detention at the facility.

The members of the visiting delegation inspected the dormitories, the community rooms and the workshops where the detainees work, they reviewed the relevant documents, and they also conducted interviews with the detainees, the management and the members of the prison service personnel.
