

**OPCAT visit**  
**to the Jász-Nagykun-Szolnok County Remand Prison**  
**15 February 2024**

On 15 February 2024, the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights and his staff visited the Jász-Nagykun-Szolnok Vármegyei prison (hereinafter referred to as the "Object").
